Article II, Section 2.05 Dues and Fees: The Board of Directors may determine dues for the general membership for each fiscal year. The Board of Directors may, in its sole discretion, determine what, if any, assessments are to be levied against Members. Nonpayment of dues or assessments shall be grounds for suspension of voting rights during the period of delinquency as determined by the Board of Directors. Dues are due and payable October 31 preceding the beginning of the membership year and become delinquent on January 1 of the membership year. Failure to pay dues by January 1 shall result in immediate and automatic revocation of a member's right to vote at any membership meeting and shall require that the delinquent member make an application to the Board of Directors for reinstatement. Contributions or gifts to the AHAA are not tax deductible as charitable contributions; however, they may be deductible as ordinary and necessary business expenses.
