Official Entry Rules

Subject:

"Arabian Horses Making a Difference in the Community" must depict elements of the Arabian Horse whose history is rich both locally and internationally. Books, Videos, the Internet and various other mediums can be used by the students to gain insight and ideas into the Arabian Horse.

Preliminary Judging

This is the responsibility of each individual school or school district. Each participating school is allowed ten entries in each division.

Final Judging

Please deliver artwork to the Arabian Horse Association office. Be sure that the Official Entry Form is complete.

Final Entries

- All submissions for final judging must be matted. Use any single WHITE mat board.
- **DO NOT** use colored mat board or poster board or mount with paper.
- **DO NOT** use colored construction paper boarders. There must not be any transparent coverings or lamination on entries.
- Each entry **MUST** have 1 hole in the upper left and right corners for hanging purposes
- **DO NOT** mount on cardboard
- **DO NOT** dry mount.
- Due to space restrictions all artwork finished size including mat board **MUST** be **NO LARGER** than 12" x 18". Smaller sizes are acceptable.
- **ALL** Artwork is due at the Arabian Horse Association by **Friday, January 15, 2010.**

Medium

Must be a **NON-SMUDGE** medium. Tempera paint, watercolor, crayon, magic marker, printmaking and mixed media are all acceptable.

Judges

The panel is composed of professionals who work in the art field, dignitaries, and representatives of the Arabian Horse Association. Judging will take place during the show.

Awards

All students who enter the Art Contest will receive a Art Contest t-Shirt from the Arabian Horse Association of Arizona. Please make sure the t-shirt size is circled. Students will be asked to attend the awards presentation. Winners will be announced and awards presented on Sunday, February 21, 2010 at 11:30 am. Participants will be awarded; Champion, Reserve Champion and Top Tens will be announced for the three categories: Kindergarten & Grade 1, Grades 2, 3 & 4 and Grades 5 & 6. Children are asked to wear their Art Contest T-shirts for the presentation.
